DECISION n° 161

of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways adopting the policy on monitoring the performance and decision-making of National Safety Authorities (NSAs)

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR RAILWAYS,

Having regard to the Regulation (EU) 2016/796 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 on the European Union Agency for Railways¹ (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”) and repealing Regulation (EC) No. 881/2004 (hereinafter called “the Regulation”), and in particular Articles 33 § 2 and 51 §1 (e) thereof,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The policy, working methods and procedure for the monitoring of the performance and decision-making of National Safety Authorities (NSAs) is adopted as set out in Annexes I-IV to this decision.

Article 2

The present decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption. It will be published on the Agency website.
